### How to Join

The club is open to all person aged over 16 years. Units cost £1 monthly and are normally purchased for a period of one year. There is no restriction on the number of units that can be held. For example a subscriber may purchase two units at an annual cost of £2 x 12 = £24. For administrative purposes it is extremely helpful if the method of payment is by Standing Order. For convenience, an authorisation form is attached. However, cheques are of course acceptable.
