The SCCA grading list has been published during the first quarter of each calendar year, then supplemented by updates from the ICCF rating system every March and September. The 2008 list was the last to calculate SCCA grades. From 2009, all grades are calculated on the ICCF system, and SCCA domestic events are administered on the ICCF webserver to allow results to be automatically fed into the ICCF system. From 2009, the ICCF grading list has been published quarterly.

October 2012 Notes

The fourth ICCF grading list of 2012 has been published and the new grades are based on 3 months' results from 1 June 2012 to 31 August 2012. The grades will apply to internationally graded games starting between 1 October and 31 December 2012.

With the publication of this ICCF rating list, Peter Bennett has achieved a 2300+ rating for the first time, and with it, an SM norm. It's been a mixture of ups, downs and no changes for everyone else.

George Pyrich joins Alan Borwell in topping 800 rated results - 808, up from 799 in the previous list, and with a 1-point grading increase to boot! Excluding overseas-based players Calos Almarza Mato and David Dempster, David Cumming is the next best with 562, with Andrew MacMillen (549) and Geoff Lloyd (544) just behind. Raymond Burridge continues to be prolific – a further 50 results in this quarter brings him up to 219 games in total, plus a grading increase of 85 points.

July 2012 Notes

The third ICCF grading list of 2012 has been published and the new grades are based on 3 months' results from 1 March 2012 to 31 May 2012. The grades will apply to internationally graded games starting between 1 July and 30 September 2012.

We have two new Scottish Masters! Gordon Anderson gained his third SM norm with an ICCF rating of 2306 on the 2012/2 list (206 games), having previously recorded grading norms in the 2009/3 and 2010/1 lists. Alan Bell gained his third SM norm with an ICCF rating of 2363 on the 2011/4 list (93 games) having previously recorded grading norms in the 2009/3 and 2010/4 lists.

With the publication of this ICCF rating list, Alan Borwell becomes our first member to top 800 rated results (803, up from 795 in the previous list) and just ahead of George Pyrich on 799. However, both are some way behind the UK record holder, former ICCF General Secretary and ICCF delegate for BFCC, Alan Rawlings who has amassed the impressive total of 972 which is nevertheless dwarfed by the astonishing number of 1,779 achieved by the current overall record holder, Theo Schmidt from the Netherlands. After Alan and George, David Cumming and Andrew MacMillen languish some way behind on 539 each. Raymond Burridge has only 169 results to date but, with 59 in the last quarter alone, may catch up before too long!

April 2012 Notes

The second ICCF grading list of 2012 has been published and the new grades are based on 3 months' results from 1 December 2011 to 29 February 2012. The grades will apply to internationally graded games starting between 1 April and 30 June 2012.

Further players have been deleted from this list due to inactivity or lapsed membership. Jim Cairney has now played sufficient games for a full rating. David Cumming and Geoff Lloyd join the happy band that has played 500+ rated games.

January 2012 Notes

The first ICCF grading list of 2012 has been published and the new grades are based on 3 months' results from 1 September to 30 November 2011. The grades will apply to internationally graded games starting between 1 January and 31 March 2012.

Further players have been deleted from this list due to inactivity or lapsed membership. Steve Murray has now played sufficient games for a full rating. Iain Mackintosh joins the small band that has played 500+ rated games.

Scottish Master Title

GM, SIM and IM titles are awarded by ICCF, and their qualifying conditions are explained on the [ICCF website](#) - follow the ICCF Titles links. The Scottish Master (SM) title is awarded by the SCCA, and its qualifying conditions are:

1. Attaining the ICCF GM, SIM or IM title.
2. Attaining 3 norms, without limit of time; one norm for each of the following:
 - o (SCCA or) ICCF grade of 2300 or above, provided this grade is based on at least 30 results in total, and on at least 20 new results since any previous norm has been awarded for grade.
 - o Outright winner of the SCCA Championship Final, or joint winner with at least 75% of total points. (Note that the SCCA Championship should be organised so that players play a minimum of 8 games for this condition to operate.)
 - o IM norm.
 - o 50% or more of the points in an ICCF World Semi-Final, or 60% or more of the points in an ICCF World Preliminary.
 - o Winner of an ICCF World or European Master Class.
3. Players must be members of the SCCA and have indicated that the SCCA is their primary CC body when norms are achieved, and the award of the title is subject to ratification by the SCCA Executive Committee.
