The SCCA grading list has been published during the first quarter of each calendar year, then supplemented by updates from the ICCF rating system every March and September. The 2008 list was the last to calculate SCCA grades. From 2009, all grades are calculated on the ICCF system, and SCCA domestic events are administered on the ICCF webserver to allow results to be automatically fed into the ICCF system. From 2009, the ICCF grading list has been published quarterly.



Grading List 2021

January 2021 Notes

The first ICCF grading list of 2021 is published and new grades are based on 3 months' results reported between 1 September 2020 and 30 November 2020. The grades will apply to internationally graded games starting between 1 January and 31 March 2021.

There were 3 new additions in this list – Benjamin Major, Theo van Stratum and Dietmar Wicht. Two players gained titles in the last grading period – Allan Buchan and Robert Montgomery, both CCE.

The most significant rating moves were Allan Buchan (+132), Martin Hardwick (+70) and John Dunn (+47) with Andrew MacMillen, Alan Sedstrem and Iain Sneddon also gaining more than 20 rating points in the quarter.

More new games centurions featured – Carlos Almarza Mato has crashed through the 1900 barrier, Martin Hardwick and Raymond Burrige are now over 1600. Andrew MacMillen (1400+), John Dunn (400+) and David Edney (300+) also reached new centuries. Highest recorded games during this quarter were Carlos Almarza Mato (100), Martin Hardwick (65), Raymond Burrige (43), Allan Buchan (35), Theo van Stratum (31), Benjamin Major and Dietmar Wicht (both 30).

April 2021 Notes

The second ICCF grading list of 2021 is published and new grades are based on 3 months' results reported between 1 December 2020 and 28 February 2021. The grades will apply to internationally graded games starting between 1 April and 30 June 2021.

If any eagle-eyed readers spotted accidental omissions from the last grading report they kept it to themselves. I noticed some omissions when preparing this report and so apologies for the errors (not all are mine). I'm not going to tell you who I missed out and you can use it as a test (although see next paragraph, the rest all had surnames that began with G!).

There were 3 new additions in this list – Kieran Rafferty, Rob Taylor (Rob should have been listed with a provisional rating previously) and yours truly after some years of inactivity. Norms were achieved by Alan Bell (IM), Gordon Anderson (IM) and Ian Whittaker (CCE) – congratulations to them with a hope for future norms. The most significant rating moves were Rob Taylor (+73 and now obtaining a full rating), David Edney (+29) and Robert Montgomery (+20). The only other double figure moves up were Andrew MacMillen (+18) and Carlos Almarza Mato (+12).

More new games centurions featured – Carlos Almarza Mato (2000+), Geoff Lloyd (1000+), Colin Beveridge (600+) and Stephen Clark (300+). Highest recorded games during this quarter were Kieran Rafferty (51), David Cumming (44), Carlos Almarza Mato (43), Raymond Burrige (33), Allan Buchan (29), Iain Sneddon (28) and Martin Hardwick (23).

July 2021 Notes

The third ICCF grading list of 2021 is published and new grades are based on 3 months' results reported between 1 Mar 2021 and 31 May 2021. The grades will apply to internationally graded games starting between 1 Jul and 30 Sep 2021.

There were no additions or deletions in this list. Allan Buchan achieved the CCM title and with his rating going over 2300 also a Scottish Master norm. CCM norms were achieved by Colin Beveridge and Robert Montgomery (2), and Wilf Taylor gained a CCE norm. Clive Murden was awarded the IA title. Congratulations to all!

The most significant rating moves were Andrew MacMillen (+74), Allan Buchan (+53), Benjamin Major (+38), Carlos Almarza Mato (+28) and Ian Whittaker (+20).

New games centurions were David Cumming (1900+), Martin Hardwick (1700+) and Iain Sneddon (400+). Highest recorded games this quarter were Carlos Almarza Mato (63), David Cumming (46), Allan Buchan (44), and Raymond BurrIDGE (36).

October 2021 Notes

The fourth ICCF grading list of 2021 is published and new grades are based on 3 months' results reported between 1 Jun 2021 and 31 Aug 2021. The grades will apply to internationally graded games starting between 1 Oct and 31 Dec 2021.

There were no additions or deletions in this list. Prof. Kevin Paine achieved the CCE title by getting his second norm in the 22nd Olympiad Preliminaries. Congratulations to Kevin!

The most significant rating moves were Ian Marshall (+61), Rob Taylor and Ian Whittaker (both +25) and Robert Gilbert (+21).

New games centurions were Carlos Almarza Mato (2100+), Raymond BurrIDGE (1700+) and Allan Buchan (200+). Highest recorded games this quarter were Carlos Almarza Mato (54), Colin Beveridge (34), Raymond BurrIDGE (33), Iain Sneddon (32), with David Cumming and Allan Buchan (both 30).

If you are ungraded, the ICCF webserver will calculate a provisional rating for your first 12 games. Provisional ratings are no longer published. After you complete 30 games, you are eligible for a published ICCF grade. Note that correspondence grades are often substantially higher than over-the-board grades. Scottish Master Title

GM, SIM and IM titles are awarded by ICCF, and their qualifying conditions are explained on the [ICCF website](#) - follow the ICCF Titles links. The Scottish Master (SM) title is awarded by the SCCA, and its qualifying conditions are:

1. Attaining the ICCF GM, SIM or IM title.
2. Attaining 3 norms, without limit of time; one norm for each of the following:
 - o (SCCA or) ICCF grade of 2300 or above, provided this grade is based on at least 30 results in total, and on at least 20 new results since any previous norm has been awarded for grade.
 - o Outright winner of the SCCA Championship Final, or joint winner with at least 75% of total points. (Note that the SCCA Championship should be organised so that players play a minimum of 8 games for this condition to operate.)
 - o IM norm.
 - o 50% or more of the points in an ICCF World Semi-Final, or 60% or more of the points in an ICCF World Preliminary.
3. Players must be members of the SCCA and have indicated that the SCCA is their primary CC body when norms are achieved, and the award of the title is subject to ratification by the SCCA Executive Committee.
